

BIO - EVA LOUKATOU

Eva Loukatou was born in Germany and raised in Athens. She studied classical guitar and started her professional career by composing the music of the movie "**Ipovrichios Erotas**" directed by Yiannis Soldatos, which shined at the 2005 Movie Festival of Thessaloniki. She also composed the music in several theatricals and also the song "**Ola dika sou**" (music and lyrics) performed by **Christina Golia**, in Michalis Kakepis' cd "Selena". The summer of 2009 releases the cd "**Etsi tha ghini**" combining masterly the music forms of tango, Balkans and Mediterranean with the dancing power of nowadays. This cd contains 8 songs and 1 instrumental, music and lyrics by Eva Loukatou. In 3 songs, the lyrics are signed by **Odysseas Ioannou, Kostas Fasoulas and George Kordellas**. The songs are performed by **Christina Golia, Sofia Papazoglou and Apostolos Rizos**. She also participates by writing the lyrics to the song "**Sta Onira**" which is in the personal cd of the singer **Salina**. The winter of 2010 creates the band **Group Phi** and starts live concerts in Athens, having high response from the audience that starting knowing her. The Group Phi is a team constituted exclusively by musicians and through it, old and new music tails are unfolded, but mainly the creations of the composer, harmonically on the stage. With **Eva Loukatou** in classic guitar and vocal, are, **Adrianos Nonis** in acoustic guitar and vocal, **Fania Krestenidi** in accordeon and vocal, **Yannis Koutsamanis** in violin, **Dimitris Pavlou** in cello, **Zacharias Alhasan** in out, **Petros Labrides** in bass and **Vaggelis Balousis** in percussions and drums.
