FALLULAH – a "foot stomping Indie diva" who just has released her debut album in Denmark "The Black Cat Neighbourhood".

It is a spiritual and organic album from her own bittersweet universe. The songs rummage somewhere between pop and bustle, Balkan rhythm, sadness and melancholy, Fallulah pushes herself over the edge and shows her flair for the impassioned and laterally rhythmic. It gives the universe an inner tension and an ear for the drama that take after trendsetting artists like Florence & The Machine and Bat For Lashes.

The first single "I Lay My Head" was "this week unavoidable" on National Danish Radio P3 and the second single "Bridges" is the 2nd most played song on National Radio P3 so far this year.
